EASA APPLICATION PROCESS for 2017-2018

- 1. Student must have successfully completed a <u>full-year Algebra 1 course</u>. In addition:
 - a. Out-of-district students AND to-be-9th graders (McMinnville district included) must pass the McMinnville High School Algebra Exit Exam, and have a grade of no less than a B in Algebra 1 for both semesters.
 - b. In-district high school students must have received a minimum grade of B in Algebra 1 (both semesters) and MAY be required to pass the Algebra Exit Exam as well
- 2. <u>Out-of-District students</u> must also transfer to the McMinnville School District <u>during the Open</u> <u>Enrollment period in March 2017</u>. If a student is accepted into the EASA program, this will reserve them a spot in the district. If a student is not accepted into EASA, the transfer will not be binding and will be revoked.
- 3. Student completes an EASA Application form and provides transcripts and teacher recommendations. **Applications are due by MAY 4, 2017**
- 4. Interview with student after reviewing their application and transcript.
 - <u>McMinnville</u> Middle School students will be interviewed May 15 May 19, 2017 at Patton and Duniway.
 - Out-of-district students will be interviewed the day of the Algebra Exit Exam
- 5. Out-of-district students, please contact Cindy Robertson at crobertson@msd.k12.or.us or 503-565-5777 to sign up to take the Algebra Exit Exam in May. The Algebra Exit Exam will be given on Tuesday, May 16, 2017 at 4:00 PM in Room 302 on the EASA Campus (Evergreen Space Museum).
