**NOTE:** Eligibility requirements include: teacher approval; C or higher grade in the MHS class at time of registration and annual fee of \$30.00 for Chemeketa CCN classes taken that school year. Registration is not mandatory, it is completely optional and students are clearly advised of that. Check student registration status directly with teacher/s. Chemeketa CCN registration for eligible students occurs twice a year, in December and March and is done completely through the high school. Other participating colleges have different timelines/processes. Students cannot register on their own nor do they register at the colleges. Taking the MHS class DOES NOT mean they are registered to receive the college credit. Check the MHS website for more information.
